

Ms. Sun graduated from the Department of Ecology at Peking University and later obtained a Master's degree in Environmental Science and Policy from George Mason University in the United States. With her academic background and practical experience, she delivered a brilliant popular science lecture on fermented foods.



Advocate for organic gardening Benefit the people of Winnipeg






